• WaterWarmth works on facilitating energy communities that are delivering the energy transition.

 Within the project we co-develop inspiring and replicable examples of cooperative aquathermal energy solutions, integrated into the local context,



with citizens from across the North sea region.

- Aquathermal energy (AE) uses thermal energy from water to provide sustainable H/C for buildings. Surface waters act as a huge solar collector and store heat in quantities that exceed by far the energy requirements for H/C.
- The project empowers energy communities to accelerate the clearly needed energy transition.
